## Minnesota Clinches Share of WCHA Championship; Colorado College Earns Fifth Home Playoff Spot; Final Six Games Tonight to Set Up First Round League Playoff Pairings

**UM, UMD, DU, UND, CC to Host First Round WCHA Playoff Series; UNO, MTU, SCSU Take Aim at Sixth Home Playoff Berth; Single Game Tickets for 2012 Red Baron™ WCHA Final Five at Xcel Energy Center Go on Sale March 5 ... Limited Number of Packages Available**

MADISON, Wis. – The final six games of the 2011-12 WCHA regular season tonight will determine the first round playoff pairings, with Wisconsin at Minnesota, Minnesota Duluth at St. Cloud State, Denver at Nebraska Omaha, Minnesota State at North Dakota, Michigan Tech at Colorado College, and Bemidji State at Alaska Anchorage.

Following last night's (March 2) games, the Golden Gophers have clinched at least a share of the WCHA regular season title and MacNaughton Cup as well as the No. 1 tournament seed and Colorado College earned the fifth first round home playoff berth. Minnesota Duluth can still earn a share of the league championship with a victory tonight and a Minnesota loss, while Nebraska Omaha, St. Cloud State and Michigan Tech are in the running for the sixth home playoff berth (see scenarios on next page).

The following WCHA playoff seeds have been determined: No. 1 Minnesota, No. 2 Minnesota Duluth, No. 3 Denver, No. 4 North Dakota, No. 11 Minnesota State and No. 12 Alaska Anchorage. The following first round match ups have also been determined: No. 12 UAA at No. 1 UM, No. 11 MSU @ No. 2 UMD.

### WCHA Men's Tie-Breaking Procedures - For Playoff Purposes Only

At the conclusion of the regular season, teams will be ranked by the number of points accumulated. If two teams are tied for first place, they will be declared co-WCHA champions.

The first round of the WCHA's post-season tournament will be a best-of-three games format at the home site of the teams ranked higher in the final regular season standings. All 12 teams participate in the first round of the tournament. First round playoff pairings will be: #1 rank vs #12 rank, #2 rank vs #11 rank, #3 vs #10, #4 vs #9, #5 vs #8, and #6 vs #7.

Following the six first round series, the six winning teams will be re-seeded #1 thru #6 according to their standings in the final WCHA in-season competition and will advance to the WCHA Final Five.

In the event that ties are encountered in the determination of WCHA ranking or designation of home teams for playoff purposes, the following procedures will be used in the order given to break the ties:

- If two or more teams are tied, head-to-head competition during the regular (conference) season will be used to break the tie.
- If two or more teams are still tied after (a), the highest seed will go to the team with the most WCHA (conference) wins during the regular season.
- If two or more teams played a four-game series during the regular season and the teams have the same win-loss records for those series and the same number of WCHA wins, the team having the least number of goals scored against it in the four-game series shall have the higher rank. If two or more teams played a two-game series during the regular season, proceed to tie-breaker d).
- If two or more teams are still tied after applying the provisions of (a), (b) and (c), the team having the greatest "winning margin" during the regular season will have the higher rank. Winning margin = WCHA goals for during the regular season minus WCHA goals against.
- Games played against WCHA opponents in holiday tournaments will not be counted in the determinations.
