## WCHA Issues One-Game Suspension to Alabama Huntsville's Reinhardt

MADISON, Wis. – The men's Western Collegiate Hockey Association today announced a one-game suspension to University of Alabama in Huntsville hockey player Ben Reinhardt as a result of his actions in the December 14 game against Minnesota State University.

Reinhardt's suspension was determined after a review by the league office of an illegal check at 13:50 of the third period and comes under the WCHA's Supplementary Discipline Policy and Procedures. At the time of the incident, Reinhardt was assessed a 5:00 major for hitting from behind and a 10:00 game misconduct.

Reinhardt will be required to serve the one-game suspension in Alabama Huntsville's next regularly scheduled contest on Friday, December 27 at University of Wisconsin.
