WCHA ANNOUNCES ONE-GAME SUSPENSION FOR ALASKA'S JOSH ERICKSON

Sophomore forward will miss Nanooks' next NCAA Division I game

EDINA, Minn. – Feb. 14, 2015 – The Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) league office today announced a one-game suspension for Alaska sophomore forward Josh Erickson, effective for the Nanooks' next NCAA Division I contest.

The suspension is a result of Erickson's game misconduct infraction for contact to the head, which occurred at the 1:57 mark of overtime in Alaska's game of Friday, Feb. 13 against Minnesota State.

Alaska's next scheduled game is tonight, Feb. 14 against Minnesota State in Fairbanks. Erickson would be eligible to return for the Nanooks' Friday, Feb. 27 contest at Alabama Huntsville.
