Michigan Tech, Nebraska Omaha, North Dakota Open 2010-11 WCHA Seasons with Victories

MTU Huskies Off to 3-0-1 Start After Win vs MSU; UNO Mavericks Open New League Chapter with Victory at UM, Move to 3-0-0 Overall; Pre-Season Favorite Sioux Upend Host BSU, Remain Unbeaten; CC, UMD, UW Post Non-Conference Wins Oct. 15... Tigers, Bulldogs Move to 2-0-1 Overall; WCHA Teams a Combined 15-4-6 (.720) in Non-Conference Play; 2011 Red Baron WCHA Final Five Set for March 17-19 at Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul

MADISON, Wis. – The first night of Western Collegiate Hockey Association action for 2010-11 saw Michigan Tech win at home and both new league member Nebraska Omaha and pre-season MacNaughton Cup favorite North Dakota win on the road. The Huskies are off to a 3-0-1 overall start after their 5-2 victory over Minnesota State Friday, the UNO Mavericks knocked off host Minnesota, 5-4, and the Sioux won the first game on the Robert H. Peters rink in the new Bemidji Regional Event Center with a 5-2 verdict over host Bemidji State before a sellout crowd of 4,373.

In non-conference play Oct. 15, Colorado College won 4-3 over Alaska Anchorage on day one of the Brice Alaska Goal Rush in Fairbanks, host Minnesota Duluth skated past Providence College, 5-3, Wisconsin blitzed visiting Alabama-Huntsville, 7-0, Denver fell 6-2 at home to Boston College and host St. Cloud State was upended by Miami, 6-3. Through games of Oct. 15, WCHA-member teams now own a combined 15-4-6 (.720)
