Minnesota Duluth Continues Season-Opening Surge with WCHA Win at BSU Friday; UND, UW, MSU, UM Victorious St. Cloud State Falls to Quinnipiac; Five WCHA Series Continue on Saturday; Tickets On Sale for 2011 Red Baron WCHA Final Five March 17-19 at Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul

MADISON, Wis. – The red-hot Minnesota Duluth Bulldogs stretched their season-opening unbeaten streak to seven games at 6-0-1 overall on Friday (Oct. 29) night with a 3-2 overtime Western Collegiate Hockey Association road victory at Bemidji State. UMD, who shares first place with North Dakota with identical 3-0-0 league records, has outscored their opponents 33-16 to date.

Also victorious in WCHA play on Friday were North Dakota, 4-3 winners over visiting and defending MacNaughton Cup Champion Denver, host Wisconsin, 5-2 victors over Michigan Tech, Minnesota State, which claimed a 3-2 decision at Alaska Anchorage, and Minnesota, who triumphed 4-1 at Colorado College.

Those four weekend conference sets conclude on Saturday (Oct. 30) as Minnesota Duluth (6-0-1, 3-0-0 WCHA) plays at Bemidji State (0-3-0, 0-3-0 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT, North Dakota (4-2-1, 3-0-0 WCHA) entertains Denver (2-3-2, 1-1-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT, Wisconsin (4-2-1, 1-1-1 WCHA) hosts Michigan Tech at 7:07 pm CT, Minnesota State (2-2-3, 2-2-1 WCHA) skates at Alaska Anchorage (1-5-1, 0-3-0 WCHA), and Colorado College (3-3-1, 1-2-0 WCHA) hosts Minnesota (4-3-0, 2-3-0 WCHA).

In non-conference play this weekend, host St. Cloud State fell to Quinnipiac 4-2 in the series opener on Friday before the two clubs face-off again on Saturday evening at 7:07 pm CT. Through games of Oct. 29, WCHA-member teams are a combined 18-11-7 (.597) record in 36 non-conference games this season.

Looking ahead to next weekend (Nov. 5-7) there are five league series on the schedule. Wisconsin travels to Minnesota, Bemidji State plays at St. Cloud State, North Dakota hosts Minnesota Duluth, Nebraska Omaha entertains Minnesota State and Denver and Colorado College play a home-and-home set. Both Alaska Anchorage and Michigan Tech will be idle.

Minnesota State 3 @ Alaska Anchorage 2 (WCHA): Despite being outshot 31-18, visiting Minnesota State prevailed 3-2 in league play over Alaska Anchorage before 2,953 at Sullivan Arena as left winger Eli Zuck netted the game-winner on a power-play at 2:17 of the third period and Phil Cook made 29 saves between the pipes. For UAA, center Justin Kirchhevel scored two goals.

Michigan Tech 2 @ Wisconsin 5 (WCHA): The host Badgers overcame a 2-0 second period deficit to win 5-2 over visiting Michigan Tech before 11,295 at the Kohl Center in Madison as left winger Michael Mersch had two goals and an assist and defenseman Jake Gardiner contributed three assists. Netting the game-winner for Wisconsin was left winger Patrick Johnson at 7:45 of the third period. For MTU, winger Ryan Furne and defenseman Ricky Doriott had goals.

Quinnipiac 4 @ St. Cloud State 2 (NC): Visiting Quinnipiac rallied for three third period goals in less than six minutes, including the winner from Spencer Heichman at 10:36 and a shorthander from Yuri Bouharevich at 15:07 in a 4-2 non-conference win over the Huskies before 5,989 at the National Hockey Center. Scoring for SCSU were Taylor Johnson and Cam Reid.

Denver 3 @ North Dakota 4 (WCHA): Center Corban Knight scored two goals, including the winner on a power-play at 1:13 of period three, and set up another to lead the host Sioux to a 4-3 league victory over the Pioneers before a sellout crowd of 11,616 at Ralph Engelstad Arena.
