Nebraska Omaha Keeps Rolling with WCHA Win at SCSU; Sioux Get Key Road Victory at UW; UMD Rallies Past MTU; Alaska Anchorage Triumphs at BSU; Host Denver Prevails Over MSU Colorado College Earns Non-Conference Win at Air Force Nov. 12; Five Weekend WCHA Series Continue on Saturday; Tigers Host ECAC Hockey-Member Yale; Tickets On Sale for 2011 Red Baron WCHA Final Five March 17-19 at Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul

MADISON, Wis. – The three teams currently at the top of the Western Collegiate Hockey Association men's standings – Minnesota Duluth, Nebraska Omaha and North Dakota – all were victorious on Friday (Nov. 12) in league play, Alaska Anchorage earned its initial league victory on the road, and defending MacNaughton Cup champion Denver prevailed at home.

The host UMD Bulldogs (8-1-2, 5-1-1 WCHA) overcame a third period deficit against Michigan Tech (3-3-2, 1-3-1 WCHA) with four third period goals in a 5-3 win, the first-year WCHA-member UNO Mavericks (8-1-0, 5-0-0 WCHA) skated to a 3-0 shutout win at St. Cloud State (4-6-1, 2-3-0 WCHA) behind a 7-for-7 penalty-killing effort to stretch their season-opening conference undefeated streak to five, and the UND Fighting Sioux (6-4-1, 5-2-0 WCHA) captured a 1-0 road win at Wisconsin (6-3-2, 3-2-2 WCHA) on a late third period goal and a stellar penalty-killing effort that saw them stifle their opponents on six extra-man chances, including two 5:00 sequences.

In Bemidji on Friday evening, visiting Alaska Anchorage (2-5-2, 1-3-1 WCHA) got in the conference win column with a 5-4 verdict over host Bemidji State (1-5-1, 1-5-1 WCHA) while in the Mile High City, the Denver Pioneers (5-4-2, 4-2-1 WCHA) edged visiting Minnesota State (2-5-4, 2-5-2 WCHA), 3-2.

Outside the WCHA on Friday night, Colorado College won 6-4 at nearby Air Force Academy, moving the league's non-conference mark this season to 20-11-7 (.618).

On Saturday (Nov. 13) all five of those WCHA weekend sets will conclude while the CC Tigers will play host

Friday, November 12 Game Re-Caps

Michigan Tech 3 @ Minnesota Duluth 5 (WCHA): Right winger Joe Basaraba's first goal of the season at 9:13 of the third period enabled the host Bulldogs to overcome a third period deficit and win 5-3 over the Huskies before 5,035 at the DECC. Tech led 2-0 after the first on goals from Brett Olson and Milos Gordic before UMD scored five unanswered goals, including two from right winger Justin Fontaine. In nets, Josh Robinson had 42 saves for the Huskies as UMD outshot their visitors 47-17.

Nebraska Omaha 3 @ St. Cloud State 0 (WCHA): Goaltender John Faulkner stopped all 23 shots on goal and left winger Ryan Walters had a goal and an assist to lead the visiting Mavericks to a 3-0 shutout win over the Huskies before a sellout crowd of 5,909 at the National Hockey Center. Center Brock Montpetit scored the game-winner for UNO at 5:20 of the first while the Mavericks' penalty-killers were a perfect 7-for-7.

North Dakota 1 @ Wisconsin 0 (WCHA): Left winger Justin Gregoire found the back of the net at 14:29 of the third period, Aaron Dell notched the shutout in nets and the Sioux held the Badgers to just 16 shots on goal in a 1-0 triumph before 13,601 at the Kohl Center. UND killed off all six UW power-plays, including two 5:00 sequences. For the UW, Scott Gudmandson had 24 saves in goal.

Alaska Anchorage 5 @ Bemidji State 4 (WCHA): Forwards Matt Bailey (2g), Brett Cameron (1g, 1a), Nick Haddad (2a) and Craig Parkinson each had two points and the visiting Seawolves overcame an early 2-0 deficit to claim a 5-4 league win over the host Beavers before 3,014 at Sanford Center. Cameron's tally, coming at 15:20 of the final period, proved to be the game-winner. Leading the way for BSU were center Matt Read, who scored two goals, center Shea Walters (2a) and defenseman Brad Hunt (2a).

Minnesota State 2 @ Denver 3 (WCHA): Defenseman David Makowski's first goal of the season, coming at 14:11 of the third period, was also the game-winner as the host Pioneers won 3-2 in WCHA play over the MSU Mavericks before 5,198 at Magness Arena. Also for DU, Sam Brittain had 31 saves between the pipes, the penalty-killers were 7-for-7, and winger Luke Salazar (1g, 1a) and center Drew Shore scored goals. Scoring for Minnesota State were right wingers Justin Jokinen and Eriah Hayes.

Colorado College 6 @ Air Force 4 (NC): the visiting Tigers hit on 4-of-6 power-play attempts and 11 players had points, led by winger Jaden Schwartz's goal and two assists, in a 6-4 non-conference win over the host Falcons before a sellout crowd of 2,974 at Cadet Ice Arena. Trailing 2-1 in the second period, CC received a shorthanded goal from winger Alexander Krushelnyski at 7:40 and a go-ahead tally from center Nick Dineen at 16:15. Scoring the game-winner for the Tigers was right winger Stephen Schultz on a power-play at 11:50 of the third.
