Minnesota Duluth, North Dakota, Denver, Minnesota, Alaska Anchorage Gain Series-Opening WCHA Victories Bulldogs, Sioux, Golden Gophers Win on Road Friday; Pioneers, Seawolves Claim Home-Ice Triumphs; Five Nov. 19-20 Weekend WCHA Series Conclude on Saturday; Tickets Continue On Sale for 2011 Red Baron WCHA Final Five March 17-19 at Xcel Energy Center in St. Paul

MADISON, Wis. – The two front-running teams in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association – No. 1 nationally-ranked Minnesota Duluth and No. 8-ranked North Dakota – stretched their winning streaks to four and three games respectively on Friday night with conference road victories and both won by identical one-goal counts. The first place Bulldogs claimed a 6-5 (ot) win at Wisconsin while the Sioux won 6-5 at No. 4-ranked Nebraska Omaha, handing the first-year league-member Mavericks their first conference defeat.

The three other victorious teams on Nov. 19 were the defending WCHA and MacNaughton Cup-champion Denver Pioneers, who prevailed 3-1 over visiting Bemidji State, the Minnesota Golden Gophers, who skated to a 6-4 triumph at Michigan Tech, and the host Alaska Anchorage Seawolves, who downed St. Cloud State 3-2 (ot).

All five of those weekend series will conclude on Saturday (Nov. 20). Minnesota Duluth (10-1-2, 7-1-1 WCHA) will face-off at Wisconsin (6-5-2, 3-4-2 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT, North Dakota (8-4-1, 7-2-0 WCHA) will go up against Nebraska Omaha (8-2-1, 5-1-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT, Denver (7-4-2, 6-2-1 WCHA) will host Bemidji State (2-6-1, 2-6-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm MT, Minnesota (6-4-1, 4-4-1 WCHA) again plays at Michigan Tech (3-5-2, 1-5-1 WCHA), and Alaska Anchorage (3-6-2, 2-4-1 WCHA) entertains St. Cloud State (4-7-2, 2-4-1 WCHA).

Then trailing 5-4 late in the third, UW winger Tyler Barnes sent the game into the extra session with an extra-attacker tally at 19:16.

North Dakota 6 @ Nebraska Omaha 5 (WCHA): Right winger Matt Frattin (2g, 1a) led the way with three points while right winger Danny Kristo scored the game-winner at 14:26 of the third period as the visiting Sioux upended the Mavericks 6-5 before 11,181 at Qwest Center Omaha. UNO took a 2-0 lead into the second period and a 4-3 advantage into the third but UND rallied with three tallies in the third for the win, including a tying goal from Frattin and a go-ahead score from defenseman Chay Genoway (1g, 1a). Leading the way for UNO were LW Terry Broadhurst (1g, 1a) and centers Alex Hudson (1g, 1a) and Joey Martin (1g, 1a).

Bemidji State 1 @ Denver 3 (WCHA): Left winger Jason Zucker and defenseman Matt Donovan each had a goal and an assist, with Zucker knocking home the game-winner at 17:05 of the second period, as the host and defending WCHA-champion Pioneers defeated the Beavers 3-1 before 4,304 at Magness Arena. Denver, winning for the third straight time, held BSU to just 15 shots on goal, with the Beavers opening the scoring on a goal by defenseman Sam Rendle at 7:54 of the first.

Minnesota 6 @ Michigan Tech 4 (WCHA): Wingers Mike Hoeffel (2g, 1a) and right winger Jake Hansen each scored two goals and the visiting Golden Gophers went 3-of-4 on the power-play en route to a 6-4 confer-

ence victory over the Huskies before 2,311 at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena. Hansen's two scores both came in the second period, with his second of the night standing up as the game-winner at 12:09. Also for UM, Jay Barriball had three assists.
