CARTER CAMPER OF MIAMI NAMED NATIONAL COLLEGE HOCKEY PLAYER OF THE MONTH

J.T. Brown of Minnesota Duluth is the
Commissioners' Choice Rookie of the Month

FARMINGTON HILLS, Mich. — Miami University senior forward Carter Camper is the Hockey Commissioners' Association National Division I Player of the Month for October.

The Rocky River, Ohio, native has scored a point in all eight of the RedHawks' games this season, leading them to a No. 1 national ranking. In seven of those contests, Camper tallied multiple points and at least one goal. He has also recorded three or more points in five games for a 2.75 points-per-game average. His nine goals and 22 points also rank first nationally, with his 13 assists putting him in a tie for the lead in that category.

The RedHawk captain, who played junior hockey for the Lincoln Stars of the USHL, began the 2010-11 campaign by posting a pair of goals and an assist in a 6-3 victory over New Hampshire, going on to register a 3-2-5 scoring line on the weekend. He was named CCHA Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 18 after registering three goals and an assist in a win and tie at St. Cloud State. After Camper recorded three points en route to shutting out Northern Michigan to open conference play on Oct. 22, he posted single-game career-highs the following night in assists (five) and points (five) as a part of a 1-7-8 weekend. Camper registered a 2-3-5 chart in the final weekend of October, with his goal and assist helping Miami to a 2-2 tie with Lake Superior State on Oct. 30. He also scored in the shootout, won 3-2 by the RedHawks. His play has helped Miami compile a 5-1-2 record in October, including a 3-0-1-1 record in CCHA play, which has the RedHawks tied for first place in the conference standings.

J.T. Brown, a freshman forward at the University of Minnesota Duluth, has been named the HCA National Rookie of the Month for October.

The Burnsville, Minn., native, who played junior hockey for the Waterloo Black Hawks of the USHL, is tied for top-scoring rookie honors in the nation with 11 points, including four goals and seven assists. Brown, who assembled a six-game scoring streak beginning Oct. 9, leads the team with a +5 rating and shares fourth place on the WCHA's overall points chart.

Brown collected four points in UMD's 7-1 win over Providence College on Oct. 15, the highest total registered by a Bulldog newcomer in over seven years. His 2-3-5 weekend earned him WCHA Rookie of the Week honors on Oct. 19. Brown scored the overtime winner in UMD's 3-2 victory over Alaska-Anchorage on Oct. 22 and assisted on the overtime winner in a 3-2 win at Bemijdi State on Oct. 29 as the Bulldogs went 6-0-2 in the month to earn a No. 2 national ranking.
