## North Dakota Moves into First Place in WCHA with Win at MSU; UNO Completes Sweep; DU, UM, CC, UW Earn Victories Friday Sioux Stretch Unbeaten String to Five, Take One Point Lead in Race for MacNaughton Cup; Top Four Separated by Three Points thru Dec. 10; Tigers on Four-Game Win Streak; League Games Saturday have CC at SCSU, BSU at UW, DU at UAA; Winter Storm Postpones Saturday's Minnesota vs Minnesota Duluth and Minnesota State vs North Dakota Games Until Sunday at 4:07 pm.

MADISON, Wis. – North Dakota rallied for three goals in the third period Friday (Dec. 10) night, with left winger Jake Maroto netting the game-winner at 10:27, to overcome host Minnesota State 4-3, stretch their unbeaten string to five games at 4-0-1, and move into sole possession of first place in the Western Collegiate Hockey Association heading into Saturday play. The rematch between the Sioux (12-5-2, 10-3-0 WCHA) and Mavericks (6-7-4, 4-7-2 WCHA) has now been postponed until Sunday at 4:07 pm CT at Verizon Wireless Center in Mankato due to a winter storm. It will be the final regular season match up between the two foes.

In the five other WCHA series being contested this week, Friday evening results saw host Nebraska Omaha complete a Thursday-Friday sweep of Michigan Tech with a 3-1 win, host Minnesota upend league-leading Minnesota Duluth 3-2, visiting Colorado College capture a 3-0 shutout victory at St. Cloud State, host Wisconsin edge Bemidji State 3-2, and Denver winning 5-3 at Alaska Anchorage.

Saturday's league slate has Colorado College (9-7-1, 6-5-0 WCHA) playing St. Cloud State (5-10-2, 3-7-1 WCHA) at the National Hockey Center at 7:07 pm CT, Wisconsin (9-7-3, 5-6-2 WCHA) entertaining Bemidji State (5-9-1, 4-8-1 WCHA), and Denver (12-5-2, 9-3-1 WCHA) taking on host Alaska Anchorage (5-10-2, 4-8-1) at Sullivan Arena at 7:07 pm AT.

A winter storm also caused Saturday's Minnesota (9-7-1, 6-6-1 WCHA) vs Minnesota Duluth (12-3-2, 9-3-1 WCHA) game at Mariucci Arena to be postponed until Sunday at 4:07 pm CT.

Heading into Saturday competition, pre-season MacNaughton Cup favorite North Dakota holds a one point

lead over second place Denver and Minnesota Duluth and a three-point advantage over fourth place Nebraska Omaha. Fifth place Minnesota, sixth place CC and Wisconsin, eighth place Minnesota State and ninth place Alaska Anchorage and Bemidji State are separated by just four points.

Looking ahead to next week, there is just one WCHA series on the docket as Nebraska Omaha visits Colorado College on Dec. 18-19. In a single non-conference match, Michigan Tech visits Northern Michigan next Friday while on Saturday, North Dakota hosts the USA Under-18 Team in an exhibition contest.

**Friday, December 10 Game Re-Caps**

**North Dakota 4 @ Minnesota State 3 (WCHA):** The line of right winger Matt Frattin (1g, 1a), center Brad Malone (3a) and left winger Evan Trupp (1g) accounted for six points and Aaron Dell made 35 saves to lead the visiting Sioux over the Mavericks, 4-3, before 4,128 at Verizon Wireless Center. MSU held a 2-1 lead in the second period after first period tallies from forward Eriah Hayes and defenseman Kurt Davis before UND rallied for three straight in the third, including the winner from winger Jake Marto at 10:27.

**Michigan Tech 1 @ Nebraska Omaha 3 (WCHA):** Center Brock Montpetit had a goal and an assist and right winger Matt Ambroz knocked home the game-winner at 3:39 of the third period as the host Mavericks completed the sweep of the Huskies 3-1 before 7,227 at Qwest Center Omaha. Scoring his first goal of the season for MTU was left winger Aaron Pietila, who tied the game at 1-1 in the second.

**Minnesota Duluth 2 @ Minnesota 3 (WCHA):** Right winger Jay Barribal netted the game-winner on a power-play at 13:36 of the middle period and Kent Patterson made 37 saves to boost the host Golden Gophers over the Bulldogs 3-2 before 9,805 at Mariucci Arena. Also scoring for host UM were center Nick Larson in the first period and right winger Nico Sacchetti in the second. For UMD, defenseman Justin Faulk brought his team within one at 3-2 when he scored on the power-play at 15:07 of the third.

**Colorado College 3 @ St. Cloud State 0 (WCHA):** Goaltender Joe Howe stopped all 26 shots on goal and right winger Tyler Johnson scored the game-winning goal at 3:07 of the first period as the visiting CC Tigers blanked the Huskies 3-0 before 5,931 at the National Hockey Center. The Tigers, who also received a goal and an assist from right winger Stephen Schultz, killed off seven of seven SCSU power-play attempts.

**Bemidji State 2 @ Wisconsin 3 (WCHA):** the host Badgers rallied from a 2-0 first period deficit behind a pair of power-play goals from center Craig Smith and 25 saves from Scott Gudmandson between the pipes to upend the Beavers 3-2 before 11,358 at the Kohl Center. Smith's second goal of the game, on a power-play at 2:32 of the third period, was the winner. Also for the UW, defenseman Justin Schultz had two assists while Radoslav Illo and Jordan George scored for BSU.

**Denver 5 @ Alaska Anchorage 3 (WCHA):** Left winger Jason Zucker scored twice, including the game-winner at 13:21 of the third period, and had one assist while center Drew Shore added a shorthander as the visiting Pioneers downed the Seawolves 5-3 before 3,267 at Sullivan Arena. DU trailed 3-2 in the third before scoring three straight. Netting a pair of goals for UAA was left winger Tommy Grant.
