St. Cloud State Launches Second Half with Florida College Classic Championship; Denver, Minnesota, BSU Return to Action Huskies Win Over Cornell, Miami; Pioneers Entertain Northern Michigan; Golden Gophers Host Bemidji State, Ferris State, Union in Dodge Holiday Classic; North Dakota Blanks UMD in Inaugural Game at AMSOIL Arena in Duluth; Wisconsin Wins vs Massachusetts; CC Finishes Second at GLIT; UNO Falls at Quinnipiac; Minnesota State Set to Play in Shillelagh Tournament Jan. 1-2; WCHA Teams Stand 32-19-9 in Non-Conference Play

MADISON, Wis. – The St. Cloud State Huskies launched the second half of their 2010-11 season in strong fashion the past two days, defeating both Cornell and Miami to claim the championship of the Florida College Classic held in Estero, Fla. In the title game vs the RedHawks on Thursday (Dec. 30) evening, the Huskies (7-11-2) rallied behind the line of left winger Nic Dowd (2g, 1a), center Drew LeBlanc (1g, 1a) and right winger Cam Reid (2a) to win 4-3.

At the Great Lakes Invitational in Detroit, Colorado College came up a goal short of the title, falling to Michigan 6-5 in the championship game on Thursday night. CC (12-9-1) defeated Michigan State 5-4 on Dec. 29. Michigan Tech, meanwhile, fell 5-3 to the Spartans in the third place contest.

In other non-conference action involving WCHA teams on Dec. 30, North Dakota (14-5-2) blanked host Minnesota Duluth (12-4-3) by a 5-0 count before a sellout crowd of 6,764 in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame game at the Bulldogs' new AMSOIL Arena as Brad Malone scored a pair of goals and Danny Kristo had three points (1g, 2a). Host Wisconsin (11-7-3) prevailed 5-1 over Massachusetts as Podge Turnbull scored twice and defenseman Frankie Simonelli had three points (1g, 2a). Out east, visiting Nebraska Omaha (12-6-1) dropped a 4-3 decision
