Defending WCHA Champion Denver Prevails at No. 1-Ranked UMD; UAA, BSU, CC, MSU, UND Earn League Victories Dec. 3 Pioneers Get Key Road Win in Series Opener; Seawolves Upend Badgers; Beavers Topple UNO in Battle of WCHA Newcomers; Tigers Triumph at Tech; MSU Mavericks Down Gophers; Sioux Skate Past Huskies, Just One Point Out of First; Full Slate of Conference Series Concludes Saturday

MADISON, Wis. – The defending Western Collegiate Hockey Association champion and No. 10-ranked Denver Pioneers (11-4-2, 8-2-1 WCHA) came up big Friday night in game one of their weekend series at No. 1-ranked Minnesota Duluth (11-2-2, 8-2-1 WCHA, upending the host Bulldogs 5-4 in overtime on center Drew Shore's goal and moving into a share of the league lead heading into Saturday night's rematch in what will be the final UMD men's game played at the DECC and the last regular season game of 2010-11 between the two foes. Face-off is set for 7:07 pm CT.

During a Dec. 3-4 weekend that features all 12 WCHA-member teams engaged in conference play, other series opens Friday night saw host and No. 7-ranked North Dakota win 3-1 over St. Cloud State, Minnesota State defeat visiting and No. 17-ranked Minnesota, 3-2, host Alaska Anchorage triumph over No. 15-ranked Wisconsin, 2-1, visiting Colorado College skate to a 7-3 decision over Michigan Tech, and host Bemidji State shut out fellow first-year league member and No. 4-ranked Nebraska Omaha, 3-0.

Those five series will all conclude on Saturday evening as North Dakota (10-5-2, 8-3-0 WCHA) hosts St. Cloud State (5-8-2, 3-5-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT at Ralph Engelstad Arena, Minnesota State (5-6-4, 3-6-2 WCHA) entertains Minnesota (8-6-1, 5-5-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT at Verizon Wireless Center, Alaska Anchorage (5-8-2, 4-6-1 WCHA) hosts Wisconsin at Sullivan Arena at 7:07 pm AT, Colorado College (7-7-1, 4-5-0 WCHA) takes on Michigan Tech (3-7-2, 1-7-1 WCHA) at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena at 7:07 pm ET, and Bemidji State (4-8-1, 3-7-1 WCHA) faces off against Nebraska Omaha (9-3-1, 6-2-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT at Sanford Center.

Friday, December 3 Game Re-Caps

Denver 5 @ Minnesota Duluth 4 ot (WCHA): Left winger Jason Zucker had a three-goal hat trick and four points and November Div. 1 player of the month and center Drew Shore scored at 3:02 of overtime to propel the visiting Pioneers 5-4 over the top-ranked Bulldogs on Friday before 5,165 at the DECC. Out shot 33-22 on the night, DU led 3-0 early in the second before UMD scored four unanswered goals, including a go-ahead tally by left winger Kyle Schmidt at 15:02 of the third. Zucker then completed his hat trick at 18:38 to tie the score at 4-4.

St. Cloud State 1 @ North Dakota 3 (WCHA): Linemates Brad Malone (C, 2g, 1a) and Matt Frattin (RW, 1g, 1a) provided the offense and Aaron Dell stopped 21 of 22 shots on goal to lead the host Sioux over the Huskies 3-1 on Friday before a sellout crowd of 11,644 at Ralph Engelstad Arena. Malone's two scores both came in the third period to unlock a 1-1 tie. Scoring for the Huskies in the first period was center Drew LeBlanc.

Wisconsin 1 @ Alaska Anchorage 2 (WCHA): Left winger Tommy Grant knocked home the game-winner at 19:51 of the third period to hand the host Seawolves a 2-1 conference victory over the visiting Badgers Friday night before 2,765 at Sullivan Arena. Center Craig Parkinson gave UAA a 1-0 lead on a shorthanded goal at 5:49 of the second before the UW tied the game on left winger Jordy Murray's power-play goal at 15:00.

Minnesota 2 @ Minnesota State 3 (WCHA): Goaltender Phil Cook made 33 saves, the host Mavericks blanked the Gophers on all five power-play chances, and left winger Adam Mueller banked the game-winner as Minnesota State won 3-2 before 4,106 at Verizon Wireless Center on Friday. Mueller's goal at 6:29 of the second period gave MSU a 3-1 advantage. Scoring for UM were forwards Nick Bjugstad and Nick Larson.

Colorado College 7 @ Michigan Tech 3 (WCHA): Center Rylan Schwartz had two goals and an assist and linemate and left wing Jaden Schwartz contributed four assists to lead the visiting Tigers over the Huskies 7-3 before 2,001 at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena on Friday night. CC, who received the game-winning goal from right winger Andrew Hamburg at 5:35 of period three, fired 47 shots on goal and hit on 2-of-5 power-plays. For MTU, Kevin Genoe had 40 saves and center Jacob Johnstone and Milos Gordic each had a goal and an assist.

Nebraska Omaha 0 @ Bemidji State 3 (WCHA): In the first match up of the season between the two new WCHA members, the host Beavers claimed a 3-0 shutout win over the Mavericks before 3,291 at Sanford Center behind 25 saves from goaltender Dan Bakala and a game-winning first period goal from defenseman Jake Areshenko. BSU blanked UNO on all six power-play chances and also received goals from right winger Ian Lowe and left winger Emil Billberg.
