Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota, Alaska Anchorage Secure WCHA Victories Friday; Top Four Teams Separated by Two Points Bulldogs Move into First Place Tie with Shutout vs UW; Golden Gophers Win at UND to Snap Sioux's Nine-Game Unbeaten Streak; Seawolves Skate Past Visiting CC; Pioneers, Mavericks Extend Unbeaten Streaks to Five with WCHA Ties

MADISON, Wis. – Minnesota Duluth, Minnesota and Alaska Anchorage all recorded victories in weekend series-opening Western Collegiate Hockey Association play on Friday (Jan. 14) night, with the host Bulldogs blanking Wisconsin 2-0 to move into a share of the league lead after the visiting Golden Gophers garnered a 3-2 triumph on the road at North Dakota. The Seawolves, meanwhile, returned to on-ice play for the first time since Dec. 11 and secured a 4-1 victory over visiting Colorado College that moved them within two points of seventh place.

The two other league series being contested this weekend saw the first games end in overtime ties as Denver deadlocked 4-4 at Minnesota State and Bemidji State tied 2-2 at Nebraska Omaha.

As a result, the current top four teams in the WCHA standings are separated by just two points with UMD and UND tied with 22, defending MacNaughton Cup champion Denver with 21, and UNO with 20.

In non-conference play Friday evening, host Michigan Tech played to a 4-4 (ot) draw with ECAC Hockey-member St. Lawrence.

Colorado College 1 @ Alaska Anchorage 4 (WCHA): Left winger Tommy Grant scored twice and set up another and the host Seawolves hit on 3-of-3 power-play attempts to down the Tigers before 2,768 at Sullivan Arena. Grant's second goal of the game, a shorthander at 13:38 of the first period, held up as the game-winner, while Rob Gunderson stopped 21 of 22 shots on goal between the pipes. UAA leads the four-game season series vs CC, 2-1-0.

Wisconsin 0 @ Minnesota Duluth 2 (WCHA): A pair of first period power-play goals from left wingers Justin Fontaine at 13:17 and Mike Connolly at 16:43 and a 22-save shutout from goaltender Kenny Reiter gave the host Bulldogs their third straight win over the Badgers this season before 6,405 at AMSOIL Arena. UMD is now 3-0-0 vs the UW this season.

Minnesota 3 @ North Dakota 2 (WCHA): Right winger Nino Sacchetti's power-play tally at 4:45 of the third period proved to be the game-winner and Kent Patterson made 35 saves in nets to lead the visiting Golden Gophers over the Fighting Sioux before a sellout crowd of 11,844 at Ralph Engelstad Arena. UM led 2-1 early in the third before Jason Gregoire knotted the score for UND with a power-play goal at 1:31. Each team went 2-of-6 on the power-play. UM leads the two-game season series vs UND, 1-0-0.

Denver 4 @ Minnesota State 4 ot (WCHA): Right winger Kyle Ostrow's extra-attacker goal at 18:44 of the third period enabled the visiting Pioneers to gain an overtime tie with the Mavericks before 3,646 at Verizon Wireless Center. MSU had just taken a 4-3 lead following right wing Justin Jokinen's goal at 18:13 of the third. All four goals for both teams were scored by different players. Denver now leads the four-game season series vs MSU, 2-0-1.

Bemidji State 2 @ Nebraska Omaha 2 ot (WCHA): The visiting Beavers improved to 2-0-1 vs the Mavericks this season after right winger Ryan Cramer netted the game-tying goal, his first tally of the season, at 16:08 of the second period for a 2-2 tie before 7,270 at Qwest Center Omaha. Right winger Matt Ambroz scored a pair of goals for the host Mavericks, tying the game at 1-1 in the first period and then giving his club a 2-1 advantage with a power-play tally at 6:55 of period two. Cramer also assisted on teammate Radoslav Illo's game-opening goal at 6:14 of the first.

St. Lawrence 4 @ Michigan Tech 4 ot (NC): Goals from right winger Milos Gordic and center Dennis Rix 1:28 apart late in the second period enabled the host Huskies to rally for a tie against the Saints before 2,017 at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena. Michigan Tech outshot SLU, 43-33.
