## It's Minnesota State vs Notre Dame at Shillelagh Tournament New Year's Day; Dodge Holiday Classic Openers See Bemidji State Win, Host UM Fall in OT; Denver Looks for Sweep vs NMU Beavers Take on Union, Gophers Go Against FSU; Wisconsin Completes Sweep of Massachusetts; St. Cloud State Earns Florida College Classic Crown; Colorado College Finishes Strong Second at GLIT; UMD Heads to Clarkson Jan. 3-4; WCHA Teams Stand 35-21-9 in Non-Conference Play

MADISON, Wis. – Minnesota State, Bemidji State, Denver and Minnesota will all be in action on New Year's day (Saturday, January 1) as Western Collegiate Hockey Association-member teams continue a busy slate of non-conference holiday competition.

Minnesota State (6-8-4) returns to on-ice play by taking on host and CCHA front-runner Notre Dame (12-6-2) at 6:05 pm CT Saturday evening in the Shillelagh Tournament at Sears Centre Arena in Hoffman Estates, Ill. The Mavericks will then face-off against either Boston University or Brown on Sunday at 2:05 pm CT.

On the second day of the Dodge Holiday Classic at Mariucci Arena in Minneapolis, Bemidji State (6-10-1) skates against Union College (11-5-3) of ECAC Hockey at 4:07 pm CT while host Minnesota plays Ferris State (9-8-3) of the CCHA at 7:07 pm CT. On Friday (Dec. 31), the Beavers won 3-2 over FSU while the Gophers fell in overtime to Union, 3-2.

And out in the Mile High City today, host Denver (13-5-3) looks to complete a two-game sweep over CCHA-member Northern Michigan (9-9-3) in a 7:07 pm MT face-off at Magness Arena.

Then on Monday (Jan. 3) and Tuesday (Jan. 4), holiday non-conference play concludes as Minnesota Duluth (12-4-3) visits ECAC-member Clarkson (10-5-2).

On Dec. 29-30, the St. Cloud State Huskies captured the Florida College Classic with wins over Cornell and Miami while the Colorado College Tigers finished a strong second at the Great Lakes Invitational in Detroit, falling to Michigan 6-5 in the championship game. CC defeated Michigan State 5-4 in the opener while Michigan Tech fell 5-3 to the Spartans in the third place contest. On Dec. 30, North Dakota blanked host Minnesota Duluth by a 5-0 count before a sellout crowd of 6,764 in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame game at the Bulldogs' new AMSOIL Arena. And in Dec. 30-31 non-conference series, host Wisconsin won twice over Hockey East-member Massachusetts (5-1, 4-2) while visiting Nebraska Omaha lost a pair of one-goal games at ECAC Hockey-member Quinnipiac (4-3, 3-2).

Through games of Dec. 31, WCHA-member teams are a combined 35-21-9 (.608) in 65 Division 1 non-conference games.

The Red Baron WCHA Final Five, held at Xcel Energy Center, has become a perennial favorite in Saint Paul and the new format will make it even better.

As the WCHA welcomes two new member teams this season in Bemidji State University and the University of Nebraska Omaha, the expanded conference has also modified its post-season format. The WCHA playoff championship will now consist of six first round, best-of-three series, at campus sites.

Following the completion of the first round, the six winning teams will advance to the Red Baron WCHA Final Five at Xcel Energy Center. The Final Five will consist of two quarterfinal games to be played on Thursday, two semi-final games Friday and the Broadmoor Trophy championship game on Saturday night. There is no longer a third place game. On championship Saturday, the Minnesota Wild will take on Columbus at 1:00 pm CT in a National Hockey League encounter.
