Defending WCHA Champ Denver Moves into First Place with Win vs UAA; Minnesota Duluth Climbs into Share of Second; Nebraska Omaha Triumphs at UND; UW, SCSU Post Friday Victories Pioneers Stretch Unbeaten Streak to Seven; Three Points Separate Current Top Four Clubs in Race for MacNaughton Cup; St. Cloud State Wins for Fifth Straight Time; Host Colorado College Blanks Alabama Huntsville Friday to Boost WCHA's Non-Conference Record to 48-23-12 (.651)

MADISON, Wis. – Defending WCHA regular season champion and No. 4-ranked Denver, following a 4-3 Friday night home-ice victory over Alaska Anchorage and sporting a seven-game unbeaten streak overall and a 8-1-2 mark over their last 11 conference outings, has moved into first place in the race for the MacNaughton Cup.

Through games of Jan. 21, the Pioneers hold a one-point advantage over both Minnesota Duluth and North Dakota and a three-point margin over Nebraska Omaha as the current top four clubs in the standings are separated by just three points. The No. 5-ranked Bulldogs won 5-0 at Michigan Tech on Friday while the first-year WCHA-member and No. 16-ranked UNO Mavericks won their first-ever league game in Grand Forks with a 8-4 victory over No. 2 North Dakota. Two other WCHA teams earning league victories on Friday were 9th-ranked Wisconsin, 3-2 over visiting Minnesota State, and St. Cloud State, 2-1 (ot) at Bemidji State. The Huskies' victory stretched their winning streak to five games.

In non-conference play Friday evening, host Colorado College blanked Alabama Huntsville 7-0 in a win that boosted the WCHA's non-conference record to 48-23-12 this season for a .651 winning percentage.

On Saturday (Jan. 22) those five league series will conclude. Denver (15-5-5, 11-3-3 WCHA) hosts Alaska Anchorage (7-11-3, 6-9-2 WCHA) at 7:07 pm MT at Magness Arena; Minnesota Duluth (16-5-3, 11-4-2 WCHA) takes on Michigan Tech (3-17-3, 1-13-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm ET at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena; North Dakota (17-7-2, 12-5-0 WCHA) entertains Nebraska Omaha (13-8-2, 10-5-2 WCHA) at Ralph Engelstad Arena; Wisconsin (16-8-3, 8-7-2 WCHA) hosts Minnesota State (10-10-5, 4-10-3 WCHA) at the Kohl Center; and visiting St. Cloud

Minnesota Duluth 5 @ Michigan Tech 0 (WCHA): The line of left winger Justin Fontaine (2g, 1a), center Travis Oleksuk (2a) and right winger J.T. Brown (1g, 2a) combined for eight points to lead the visiting Bulldogs to a 5-0 WCHA win over MTU before 2,010 at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena. Brown's game-opening goal at 4:07 of the second period was the game-winner while Kenny Reiter stopped all 14 shots on goal for the shutout. UMD leads the season series vs Tech, 3-0-0.

Minnesota State 2 @ Wisconsin 3 (WCHA): Left winger Michael Mersch's goal at 18:44 of period two held up as the game-winner and Scott Gudmandson made 37 saves in nets as the host Badgers prevailed by one goal over the Mavericks before 14,037 at the Kohl Center. Trailing 1-0, Wisconsin scored three times in the second period with defenseman Justin Schultz assisting on two. For MSU, right winger Mike Louwerse (1g, 1a) scored at 14:57 of the third to close the gap to 3-2. UW leads the two-game season series, 1-0-0.

Alaska Anchorage 2 @ Denver 3 (WCHA): Center Kyle Ostrow scored twice, left winger Anthony Maiani had two assists, and right winger Beau Bennett notched the game-winner at 9:22 of the third period as the host Pioneers won over the Seawolves and moved into first place in the WCHA before 5,084 at Magness Arena. For UAA, center Matt Bailey (1g, 1a) tied the game at 2-2 with a goal at 2:21 of the third. DU is 2-0-1 vs UAA.

Nebraska Omaha 8 @ North Dakota 4 (WCHA): Center Joey Martin (3g, 1a) notched a hat trick, defensemen Michael Young (1g, 2a) and Eric Olimb (3a) each had three points, and the Mavericks hit on 5-of-8 power-plays in a 8-4 triumph over North Dakota before a sellout crowd of 11,845 at Ralph Engelstad Arena. The win was the first for UNO in Grand Forks as a WCHA member and marked the return of former Sioux head coach Dean Blais. UND, led by a pair of goals from defensemen Chay Genoway, scored three times in the third. UNO leads the season series, 2-1-0.

St. Cloud State 2 @ Bemidji State 1 ot (WCHA): Right winger Nic Dowd scored at 4:32 of overtime and Mike Lee had 22 stops as visiting St. Cloud State downed BSU 2-1 for their fifth straight victory before 4,373 at Sanford Center. Defensemen Nick Jensen put SCSU up 1-0 with a second period goal before BSU center Matt Read tallied on the power-play at 18:45 of the second to tie the game at 1-1. SCSU leads the season series, 2-1-0.

Alabama-Huntsville 0 @ Colorado College 7 (NC): Center Archie Skalbeck scored twice, right winger Tyler Johnson added 1-2=3, 13 players had points and as the host Tigers blanked the Chargers 7-0 before 5,971 at Colorado Springs World Arena. CC was 3-of-5 on the power-play.
