## Colorado College, Minnesota, Wisconsin Earn WCHA Victories Friday; St. Cloud State Extends Unbeaten Streak to Seven with Tie vs MSU; Four League Series Continue Saturday

**Tigers Gain Key Win vs North Dakota; Golden Gophers Skate Past UAA; Badgers Triumph at MTU; Five Points Separate Top Five in Current Standings; Host Nebraska Omaha Blanks Alabama Huntsville to Boost WCHA's Non-Conference Record to 50-23-12 (.659)**

MADISON, Wis. – Colorado College, Minnesota and Wisconsin all earned Western Collegiate Hockey Association victories on Friday (Jan. 28) night to boost their positions in the standings and improve their chances of earning an upper division finish and home ice for the first round of league playoffs in six weeks.

The host Tigers defeated North Dakota, 4-2, the Golden Gophers skated past visiting Alaska Anchorage, 5-1, and the Badgers won 4-2 at Michigan Tech to run their winning streak to four. Colorado College and Minnesota are currently tied for sixth place thru games of Jan. 28, while Wisconsin has moved into a share of fourth.

In the one other league series being contested this week, host St. Cloud State played to a 3-3 (ot) tie with Minnesota State on Friday, with the Huskies stretching their unbeaten streak to seven games at 6-0-1. SCSU is just two points back of CC and UM.

And in non-conference play Friday, host Nebraska Omaha blanked Alabama Huntsville 4-0 in a win that pumped up the WCHA's non-conference record to 50-23-12 this season for a .659 winning percentage.

On Saturday (Jan. 29), conference games will feature Colorado College (15-11-1, 9-8-0 WCHA) hosting North Dakota (18-8-2, 13-6-0 WCHA) at 7:07 pm MT at Colorado Springs World Arena (7,380), Minnesota (11-9-3, 8-7-2 WCHA) entertaining Alaska Anchorage (7-13-3, 6-11-2 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT at Mariucci Arena (10,000), Wisconsin (18-8-3, 10-7-2 WCHA) taking on Michigan Tech (3-19-3, 1-15-1 WCHA) at 7:07 pm ET at John M. Clines Student Ice Arena (4,128), and St. Cloud State (11-11-3, 7-8-2 WCHA) engaging visiting Minnesota State (10-11-6, 4-11-4 WCHA) at the National Hockey Center (5,371). Both North Dakota and Wisconsin will be idle.

**Friday, January 28 Highlights**

**North Dakota 2 @ Colorado College 4 (WCHA):** Outshot 20-8 in the first period, the host Tigers nonetheless led 2-0 and then scored twice more in the second for a four-goal cushion, with right winger Jeff Collett netting the game-winner at 5:42 and Joe Howe making a total of 38 saves, en route to a 4-2 conference win over the Fighting Sioux before a sellout crowd of 7,540 at the World Arena. Left winger Alexander Krushelnyski (1g, 1a) and right winger Tyler Johnson (2a) led the Tigers with two points each. UND received a pair of goals from left winger Jason Gregoire in the third, including a shorthander. Both teams finished with 40 shots on goal, with Aaron Dell making 36 stops for the Sioux. CC is 1-0-0 vs UND this season.

**Alaska Anchorage 1 @ Minnesota 5 (WCHA):** Five players scored goals for the host Golden Gophers, with left winger Tom Serratore scoring the game-winner at 5:32 of the first period and goaltender Kent Patterson stopped 28 of 29 shots, in a 5-1 WCHA victory over visiting Alaska Anchorage before 9,639 at Mariucci Arena. UM held a 48-29 advantage in shots on goal and received two points apiece from RW Jake Hansen (1g, 1a), center Nick Larson (1g, 1a) and defenseman Justin Holl (2a). For UAA, right winger Mitch Bruijsten netted a power-play goal at 18:44 of the first period to make the score 2-1 and Rob Gunderson made 43 saves. UM leads the season series, 1-0-0.

**Wisconsin 4 @ Michigan Tech 2 (WCHA):** Right winger Tyler Barnes had a goal and an assist and right winger Mark Zengerle knocked home the game-winner at 13:42 of the second period as the visiting Badgers downed the host Huskies 4-2 before 2,211 at John MacInnes Student Ice Arena and take a 3-0-0 season series advantage. Michigan Tech took a 2-1 lead in the second on back-to-back goals from right winger Alex MacLeod at 0:41 and center Evan Witt at 3:18 before the UW scored the final three. Both clubs were 0-of-3 on the power-play.

**Minnesota State 3 @ St. Cloud State 3 ot (WCHA):** Center Drew LeBlanc tallied twice, including the game-tying goal at 13:16 of the second period, to help the host Huskies gain a 3-3 (ot) WCHA tie with the Mavericks before 5,963 at the National Hockey Center. Trailing 2-1 after one, MSU received back-to-back goals from defensemen Kurt Davis and Ben Youds in the first 10:00 of the second to go up 3-2. Top point-getters in the game were SCSU left winger Jared Festler (1g, 2a) and MSU left winger Michael Dorr (3a). The two-game season series is tied at 0-0-1.

**Alabama-Huntsville 0 @ Nebraska Omaha 4 (NC):** Left winger Rich Purslow had a goal and an assist, center Alex Hudson netted the game-winner and John Faulkner notched a 20-save shutout as host UNO blanked the Charger 4-0 before 6,376 at Qwest Center Omaha.
