Minnesota Duluth at Clarkson Jan. 3-4 to Conclude WCHA's Holiday Non-Conference Schedule; Minnesota State Captures Shillelagh Tournament Title

Bemidji State Claims Dodge Holiday Classic Crown; St. Cloud State Earns Florida College Classic Championship; Colorado College Finishes Strong Second at GLIT; WCHA Teams Stand 38-21-11 (.633) in Non-Conference Play; League Play Resumes Jan. 7 as SCSU Hosts MTU

MADISON, Wis. – Minnesota Duluth is on the road Monday (Jan. 3) and Tuesday (Jan. 4) to take on Clarkson of ECAC Hockey in a pair of games that will conclude a busy holiday non-conference schedule for Western Collegiate Hockey Association-member men's teams. Face-offs between the Bulldogs (12-4-3) and Golden Knights (10-5-2) are set for 7:00 pm ET each evening.

Beginning Dec. 29 when on-ice play resumed after the Christmas break, WCHA-member clubs are a combined 10-6-2 in non-conference match ups. And overall this 2010-11 season, WCHA teams are 38-21-11 (.633) in 70 Div. 1 non-conference outings.

Most recently, Minnesota State earned a third holiday tournament championship by a WCHA team when the Mavericks won the Shillelagh Tournament at Sears Centre Arena in Hoffman Estates, Ill. MSU defeated both host Notre Dame 4-3 on Jan. 1 and Brown 7-3 on Jan. 2. Leading the way for the Mavericks in the title game against Brown were the line of left winger Michael Dorr (2g, 1a), center Andrew Sackrison (2a) and right winger Eriah Hayes (1g, 1a) while center Eli Zuck added three assists and defenseman Kurt Davis had the game-winner.

Mariucci Arena in Minneapolis and St. Cloud State in the Florida College Classic at Germain Arena in Estero, Fla. The Beavers downed Ferris State 3-2 on Dec. 31 and Union College 3-1 on Jan. 1. For BSU in the title game, Matt Read scored a pair of goals and Dan Bakala stopped 30 of 31 shots on goal between the pipes. The SCSU Huskies, meanwhile, prevailed over both Cornell (4-3 ot) on Dec. 29 and Miami (4-3) on Dec. 30.

The Colorado College Tigers finished a strong second at the Great Lakes Invitational in Detroit on Dec. 29-30, falling to Michigan 6-5 in the championship game. CC defeated Michigan State 5-4 in the opener while Michigan Tech fell 5-3 to the Spartans in the third place contest. On Dec. 30, North Dakota blanked host Minnesota Duluth by a 5-0 count before a sellout crowd of 6,764 in the U.S. Hockey Hall of Fame game at the Bulldogs' new AMSOIL Arena. In a pair of Dec. 30-31 non-conference series, host Wisconsin won twice over Hockey East-member Massachusetts (5-1, 4-2) while visiting Nebraska Omaha lost a pair of one-goal games at ECAC Hockey-member Quinnipiac (4-3, 3-2). And on Dec. 31-Jan. 1, host Denver won (5-2) and tied (2-2 ot) against Northern Michigan.

Upcoming this weekend (Friday, Jan. 7 and Saturday, Jan. 8) Michigan Tech visits St. Cloud State in WCHA play while non-conference matchups have Bemidji State at Alabama-Huntsville, Canisius at Wisconsin, American International at Minnesota State and Robert Morris at North Dakota. In exhibition contests, the U.S. Under-18 Team plays at Minnesota Friday and Minnesota Duluth Saturday.
