Colorado College, Nebraska Omaha, Alaska Anchorage, Minnesota State Collect WCHA Victories Friday as Home Teams Go 4-0-1; Minnesota Duluth Plays to Tie vs Minnesota One Point Separates Top Three in UND, DU and UMD; Four Points Between Top Five

MADISON, Wis. – Colorado College, Nebraska Omaha, Alaska Anchorage and Minnesota State all protected friendly ice on Friday (Feb. 4) night in Western Collegiate Hockey Association action while Minnesota Duluth played to a tie as the five home teams combined for a 4-0-1 mark. The Tigers downed arch-rival Denver, 3-2, the UNO Mavericks blanked St. Cloud State, 3-0, the Seawolves skated past Michigan Tech, 4-1, and the MSU Mavericks prevailed 2-1 in overtime over Bemidji State. In Duluth, the Bulldogs played to a 2-2 (ot) tie against Minnesota.

On Saturday (Feb. 5), those five weekend series will conclude as Denver (16-6-5, 12-4-3 WCHA) hosts Colorado College (16-12-1, 10-9-0 WCHA) at Magness Arena in Denver at 7:07 pm MT, Nebraska Omaha (15-10-2, 11-6-2 WCHA) entertains St. Cloud State (11-13-3, 7-10-2 WCHA) at 7:07 pm CT at Qwest Center Omaha, Alaska Anchorage (9-13-3, 8-11-2 WCHA) takes on Michigan Tech (3-21-2, 1-17-1 WCHA) at Sullivan Arena, Minnesota State (12-11-6, 6-11-4 WCHA) engages Bemidji State (9-14-2, 5-12-2 WCHA) at Verizon Wireless Center at 7:07 pm CT, and Minnesota Duluth (17-5-4, 12-4-3 WCHA) again hosts Minnesota (11-10-4, 8-8-3 WCHA) at AMSOIL Arena at 7:07 pm CT.

Through games of Feb. 4, idle North Dakota (19-8-2, 14-6-0 WCHA, 28 points) holds a one-point lead in the MacNaughton Cup race over second place Denver and Minnesota Duluth, who each have 27 points but one game in hand. Nebraska Omaha and idle Wisconsin (19-8-3, 11-7-2 WCHA) are tied for fourth with 24 points, but UNO has one game in hand. Colorado College is sixth with 20 points, Minnesota is one back of the Tigers in seventh with 19, UAA is one back of the Gophers in eighth with 18 and SCSU and MSU are tied for ninth with 16 points each, although the Huskies have played two less league games. BSU is 11th (12 points) and MTU is 12th (3 points).

Friday, February 4 Highlights

Denver 2 @ Colorado College 3 (WCHA): Left winger Alexander Krushelnyski's goal at 5:38 of the second period gave the host Tigers a second two-goal cushion and held up as the game-winner in a 3-2 WCHA win over the Pioneers before a sellout crowd of 7,571 at the World Arena. Center Archie Skalbeck and right winger William Rapuzzi scored :56 seconds apart in the first period for a 2-0 CC lead. DU twice pulled within one on a second period goal from center Drew Shore and a power-play, extra-attacker goal from Kyle Ostrow at 19:37 of the third, with Jason Zucker assisting on both. CC leads the season series, 2-1-0.

St. Cloud State 0 @ Nebraska Omaha 3 (WCHA): Outshot 33-29, the host Mavericks nonetheless prevailed 3-0 over the Huskies before 7,112 at Qwest Center Omaha as John Faulkner earned the shutout between the pipes and defenseman Eric Olimb led the way offensive with the game-winning goal and an assist. Olimb scored the first goal of the game at 3:22 of the second period, the game-winner, and that was followed quickly by tallies from center Brock Montpetit at 4:37 and right winger Matt Ambroz at 5:03. UNO leads the season series vs SCSU, 2-0-1.

Michigan Tech 1 @ Alaska Anchorage 4 (WCHA): Defenseman Curtis Leinweber scored twice, including a shorthander, blueliner Wes McLeod tallied the game-winner and the host Seawolves held the Huskies to 14 shots on goal in a 4-1 WCHA victory before 2,638 at Sullivan Arena. McLeod's goal, coming on a power-play at 14:34 of the period two, gave UAA a 2-1 advantage. Scoring for the Huskies was right winger Milos Gordic, whose power-play tally at 2:16 of the second tied the score at 1-1. Alaska Anchorage leads the two-game season series, 1-0-0.

Bemidji State 1 @ Minnesota State 2 ot (WCHA): An unassisted goal by defenseman Channing Boe at 2:32 of overtime gave the host Mavericks a 2-1 triumph over the Beavers before 3,672 at Verizon Wireless Center. Minnesota State, going up 1-0-0 in the two-game season series, outshot the Beavers 43-19, who received a 41-save effort from goaltender Dan Bakala. MSU defenseman Ben Youds scored the game's first goal at 13:19 of the first period before BSU center Jordan George tied the game at 17:35 of the third.

Minnesota 2 @ Minnesota Duluth 2 ot (WCHA): Left winger Mike Connolly's goal at 10:12 of the second period enabled the host Bulldogs to forge a 2-2 (ot) WCHA draw against the visiting Golden Gophers before a sellout crowd of 6,764 at AMSOIL Arena. Minnesota led 1-0 after one on defenseman Cade Fairchild's power-play marker and then again at 2-1 in the second after an unassisted goal by right winger Jay Barriball at 8:42. In nets, Kent Patterson had 40 stops for UM while Kenny Reiter had 36 saves for UMD. Minnesota leads the season series, 1-0-2.
