WCHA Play Resumes with Three League Series for Jan. 6-7 as No. 1-Ranked Wisconsin Visits No. 2-Ranked Minnesota; Bemidji State Hosts Minnesota State; Ohio State Heads to St. Cloud State North Dakota Takes on Lindenwood in Non-Conference Matchup Jan. 4; WCHA-Member Teams Sport Impressive 32-7-6 (.778) Non-Conference Record; Latest USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine Div. 1 Women's Weekly Poll for Jan. 3 has Five WCHA Teams Among Top 10 ... Badgers Remain a Unanimous No. 1, UM No. 2, UND No. 6, UMD No. 9, BSU No. 10

MADISON, Wis. – With all but one non-conference game behind them, the eight women's Western Collegiate Hockey Association-member teams give their full attention to the final seven weeks of the 2011-13 conference season and the jockeying for playoff spots that are ahead of them.

It begins this week with three league series, including the best matchup in the country between long-time rivals Wisconsin, the defending WCHA and national champions, and Minnesota. Those two teams hold the top two spots in the latest national polls and the rivals are also No. 1 and No. 2 in the WCHA standings. The Badgers (19-1-0, 13-1-0 WCHA) and Golden Gophers (17-3-0, 11-3-0 WCHA) resume their Border Battle at UM's Ridder Arena (3,400) this Friday, Jan. 6, at 7:07 pm CT and the series concludes on Saturday afternoon at 4:07 pm CT. Minnesota is the only team to beat the Badgers so far this season. This will be the eighth and ninth consecutive games in which both the Gophers and Badgers are ranked among the nation's top-10. The games will also be the sixth and seventh times the two teams have played each other as the nation's two best teams. The two teams split a pair of 3-2 games at the Kohl Center in Madison on Oct. 14/16.

The other two league series this weekend have Ohio State at St. Cloud State and Minnesota State at Bemidji State. The Buckeyes (9-7-4, 6-7-1-1 WCHA) and Huskies (2-16-2, 1-13-0 WCHA) will face-off at the

National Hockey Center (5,371) in St. Cloud at 7:07 pm CT on Friday evening and 2:07 pm CT on Saturday afternoon. The host Beavers (12-7-2, 6-7-1 WCHA) and Mavericks (6-14-0, 2-12-0 WCHA) will lace-up the skates for a pair of 7:07 pm CT encounters at BSU's Sanford Center (4,373).

On Wednesday (Jan. 4), North Dakota (12-7-1) will entertain first-year Div. 1 independent Lindenwood (1-18-0) at 7:07 pm CT at Ralph Engelstad Arena (11,634) in Grand Forks, in the final non-conference game involving a WCHA-member team this season.

A look at the WCHA standings heading into the second half shows Wisconsin (19-1-0, 13-1-0-0 WCHA) at the top with 39 points, six more than Minnesota (17-3-0, 11-3-0-0 WCHA). North Dakota (12-7-1, 9-5-1-0 WCHA) is in third place with 28 points and Minnesota Duluth (11-8-1, 8-7-1-1 WCHA) has moved into fourth with 26 points. Ohio State (8-7-3, 6-7-1-1 WCHA) is in fifth place with 20 points, one ahead of Bemidji State (12-7-2, 6-7-1-0 WCHA). Minnesota State (6-14-0, 2-12-0-0 WCHA) has six points for the seventh spot while St. Cloud State (2-16-2, 1-13-0-0 WCHA) is eighth with three points.

The league race may crystalize this month as Wisconsin follows up its Jan. 6-7 series with Minnesota with a trip to North Dakota Jan. 14-15 and then hosts Minnesota Duluth Jan. 20-21. Meanwhile, Minnesota plays at UMD Nov. 14-15 after its Border Battle this weekend.

The WCHA continued to flex its muscle in non-conference play this season as Bemidji beat Robert Morris twice by identical 3-2 scores in Pittsburgh last weekend while host Ohio State tied Princeton 2-2 (ot) and 1-1 (ot). Three times over the weekend the Buckeyes took one-goal leads, but the visiting Tigers answered on each occasion, resulting in draws. Senior Rachel Weber stopped 82 of 85 shots on the weekend for Princeton.

Bemidji State used the same scenario to get its one-goals wins: BSU jumped out to a 2-0 lead, RMU battled back to tie, and the Beavers scored the deciding goal in the final 10 minutes. Tess Dusik tipped in Marlee Wheelhouse's drive and got the game-winner in the series finale and Kimberly Lieder in the series opener.

Those Dec. 30-31 results mean that WCHA teams now have a .778 winning percentage against opponents from other Division 1 conferences so far this season, with a 32-7-6 overall mark with the one UND game remaining on Wednesday. WCHA teams are 6-0-2 (.875) vs ECAC Hockey, 13-2-1 (.844) vs. the Hockey East Association, 8-5-3 (.594) vs. College Hockey America, and 5-0-0 vs. Independents.

In this week's USA Today/USA Hockey Magazine Women's Div. 1 College Hockey Poll for Jan. 3, Wisconsin was a unanimous No. 1, Minnesota was No. 2, North Dakota was No. 6, Minnesota Duluth was No. 9 and Bemidji State was No. 10.

In the most recent USCHO.com Women's Div. 1 College Hockey Poll issued for Dec. 12, Wisconsin was a unanimous No. 1, Minnesota was No. 2, North Dakota was No. 6, Bemidji State was No. 8 and Minnesota Duluth was No. 9. Also receiving votes from the WCHA was Ohio State.

mark and .950 winning percentage, Minnesota is 17-3-0 with a .850 winning percentage, North Dakota is at 12-7-1 and .625, Bemidji State is at 12-7-2 and .619, Minnesota Duluth is at 11-8-1 and .575, and Ohio State is at 9-7-4 and .550.

Looking ahead to the weekend of Friday-Sunday, Jan. 13-15, there will be a full complement of four Western Collegiate Hockey Association series contested. Minnesota will play at Minnesota Duluth (Friday/Saturday), Ohio State will head to Bemidji State (Friday/Saturday), Minnesota state will host St. Cloud State (Friday/Saturday), and North Dakota will host Wisconsin (Saturday/Sunday).

The WCHA schedule of 28 games per member team will conclude the weekend of Feb. 17-18. Following those final four series, the eight teams will be re-ranked No. 1 through No. 8 according to their regular season finish and advance to a first round of WCHA Playoffs.

The first round best-of-three series will be contested Friday-Sunday, Feb. 24-26, with No. 1 hosting No. 8, No. 2 hosting No. 7, No. 3 hosting No. 6 and No. 4 hosting No. 5.

The four first round WCHA playoff winners will then advance to the 2012 WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF, set for Friday, March 2 and Saturday, March 3 at AMSOIL Arena in Duluth, Minn. There will be two semi-finals played on Friday at 4:07 pm and 7:07 pm CT with the championship contest slated for 7:07 pm CT on Saturday.

Following the WCHA tournament, there will be a March 9-11 round of NCAA Regionals at sites to be determined, followed by the 2012 NCAA Women's Frozen Four back at AMSOIL Arena on March 16 and 18.

Home to a record 12 consecutive national championship teams, including the latest NCAA Frozen Four crown won by Wisconsin last spring, the women's WCHA marks its 13th season in 2011-12.

WCHA Women's Tie-Breaking Procedures - For Playoff Purposes Only

At the conclusion of the regular season, teams will be ranked by the number of points accumulated. If two teams are tied for first place, they will be declared co-WCHA champions.

The first round of the WCHA's post-season tournament will be a best-of-three games format at the home site of the teams ranked higher in the final regular season standings. All eight teams participate in the first round of the tournament. First round playoff pairings will be: #1 rank vs #8 rank, #2 rank vs #7 rank, #3 vs #6, and #4 vs #5.

Following the four first round series, the four winning teams will be re-seeded #1 thru #4 according to their standings in the final WCHA in-season competition and will advance to the WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF.

In the event that ties are encountered in the determination of WCHA ranking or designation of home teams for playoff purposes, the following procedures will be used in the order given to break the ties:

- If two or more teams are tied, head-to-head competition during the regular (conference) season will be used to break the tie.
- If two or more teams are still tied after (a), the highest seed will go to the team with the most WCHA (conference) wins during the regular season.
- If two or more teams played a four-game series during the regular season and the teams have the same win-loss records for those series and the same number of WCHA wins, the team having the least number of goals scored against it in the four-game series shall have the higher rank. If two or more teams played a two-game series during the regular season, proceed to tie-breaker d).
- If two or more teams are still tied after applying the provisions of (a), (b) and (c), the team having the greatest "winning margin" during the regular season will have the higher rank. Winning margin = WCHA goals for during the regular season minus WCHA goals against.
- Games played against WCHA opponents in holiday tournaments will not be counted in the determinations.
- Shootout wins used during the WCHA regular season will not be counted in the determinations. Shootout games will be recorded as a tie in the determinations.
