## Full Compliment of WCHA Series Set for Feb. 10-11 as BSU Hosts UMD, UW Visits SCSU, OSU Hosts UM, UND Travels to MSU; Badgers Hold Six-Point Lead in Race for League Championship; UND, UMD, OSU Battle for Two Remaining Home Playoff Berths

**Wisconsin, Minnesota, North Dakota Log Feb. 3-4 Sweeps; McIntosh Becomes Buckeyes' All-Time Leading Scorer in Split with Bulldogs; UND's Lamoureux Tops Nation's Scorers, UM's Rätty Tops Div. 1 Goaltenders; Latest USCHO.Com Women's Div. 1 National Poll has Wisconsin No. 1, Minnesota No. 2, North Dakota No. 4, Minnesota Duluth No. 9 ... BSU Also Receives Votes; WCHA-Member Teams 33-7-6 (.783) in Non-Conference Play; Ticket Packages On Sale for 2012 WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF, March 2-3 at AMSOIL Arena in Duluth**

MADISON, Wis. – The Western Collegiate Hockey Association heads into the final two-week stretch of the 2011-12 regular season this weekend as top-ranked and defending national champion Wisconsin tries to hold off Minnesota in the battle for first place and the conference title, North Dakota looks to clinch third place and Minnesota Duluth and Ohio State continue their battle for the last home playoff spot.

A total of 16 league games remain – four per team – with eight of those occurring this coming weekend of Feb. 10-11 as Wisconsin heads to St. Cloud State, Minnesota plays at Ohio State, Minnesota Duluth travels to Bemidji State and Ohio State hosts Minnesota in Friday-Saturday games.

In Bemidji, the BSU Beavers (14-14-3, 8-14-2 WCHA) entertain the No. 9-ranked UMD Bulldogs (15-12-1, 12-11-1-1 WCHA) on Friday and Saturday afternoons at Sanford Center (4,373), with both face-offs set for 2:07 pm CT. The two teams split their first two-game set back on Nov. 19-20 in Duluth, with the Bulldogs taking game one 4-1 and the Beavers prevailing in game two 4-3.

In Columbus, Ohio State (15-11-4, 12-11-1-1 WCHA) will play host to No. 2-ranked Minnesota (24-4-2, 18-4-2-1 WCHA) on Friday and Saturday in 7:07 pm ET and 4:07 pm ET puck-drops at the OSU Ice Rink (800). In their first two-game match up back on Dec. 10-11 in Minneapolis, the Golden Gophers won by 4-1 and 3-1 counts.

Over in Mankato, Minnesota State (7-23-0, 3-21-0 WCHA) skates against No. 4-ranked North Dakota (18-9-2, 14-8-2-1 WCHA) in a pair of contests at All Seasons Arena (750). Friday evening's game gets underway at 7:07 pm CT while Saturday's tilt commences at 3:07 pm CT. UND stands 2-0 against the Mavericks so far this winter, after being victorious by 5-3 and 6-1 scores in Grand Forks on Nov. 18-19.

And at the National Hockey Center (5,371) in St. Cloud, the SCSU Huskies (5-23-2, 4-20-0 WCHA) go up against the No. 1-ranked UW Badgers (26-2-2, 20-2-2-1 WCHA) in a 7:07 pm CT face-off on Friday night and a 2:07 pm CT start on Saturday afternoon. In this season's first head-to-head meetings back on Nov. 25 & 27 in Madison, Wisconsin came out on top by 5-0 and 6-1 margins.

Heading into the final two weeks, the WCHA standings have Wisconsin (20-2-2-1 WCHA) at the top with 63 points, six more than second place Minnesota (18-4-2-1 WCHA) with 57. North Dakota (14-8-2-1 WCHA) is in third place with 45 points, seven better than Minnesota Duluth (12-11-1-1 WCHA) and Ohio State (12-11-1-1) who own identical records and 38 points each. Bemidji State (14-2-0 WCHA) holds down the sixth spot with 26 points, St. Cloud State (4-20-0 WCHA) is seventh with 12 points, and Minnesota State (3-21-0 WCHA) is eighth with nine points.

After the conclusion of the regular season on Feb. 18, the first round of WCHA Playoffs – a best-of-three format – will be contested the following weekend of Friday, Feb. 24 through Sunday, Feb. 26. All eight teams will participate in the playoffs, with the No. 1 seed hosting the No. 8 seed, No. 2 hosting No. 7, No. 3 hosting No. 6 and No. 4 hosting No. 5.

The four first round winners will then advance to the league playoff championship – the WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF – which will be contested Friday, March 2 and Saturday, March 3 at AMSOIL Arena in Duluth. There will be two semi-finals played on Friday at 4:37 pm CT and 7:37 pm CT while the championship contest will face-off at 7:07 pm CT on Saturday.

Following the league tournament, the NCAA Regionals will be played the weekend of March 9-11 with the 2012 NCAA Women's Frozen Four to be held March 16 & 18 at AMSOIL Arena in Duluth.

After last weekend's (Feb. 3-4) results, little changed in the WCHA, where the top three swept the bottom three, and Minnesota Duluth and Ohio State split and remain deadlocked for fourth place and the right to host a first round WCHA playoff series.

Visiting Minnesota won two games at St. Cloud State and wrapped up a first round home playoff spot. Golden Gophers' right winger

– End of Regular Season –

Amanda Kessel had eight points against the host Huskies last weekend, including a career-best six points in last Friday's 8-1 win with two goals (on three shots) and four assists. With those six points, she becomes one of nine players in Gopher women's hockey history to score six points in a single game, a mark that ranks second in the Minnesota record book. Then last Saturday, Kessel had two more points with a goal and an assist, and goaltender Noora Rätty became the school's career shutouts record holder with 22 in Minnesota's 7-0 victory at SCSU. Defenseman Megan Bozek, who had a career-best four assists in game one, came back with two more in game two. Rätty's shutout was her sixth this season.

At the Kohl Center in Madison last weekend, Wisconsin beat Minnesota State twice, 5-2 on Friday and 6-0 on Sunday. Left winger Brittany Ammerman had two goals in each game for the Badgers, while the series finale marked Wisconsin's ninth shutout of the season.

Up at AMSOIL Arena in Duluth, Ohio State and Minnesota Duluth split a vital two-game series. The host Bulldogs used four goals in the first 12 minutes of play last Friday, with center Katherine Wilson netting the game-winner at the 7:00 mark to knock off the Buckeyes 4-2. The start was the most goals UMD has scored in the first period since Jan. 30, 2009, when they tallied five times en route to a 7-2 win over St. Cloud State. Senior center Haley Irwin and junior left winger Audrey Cournoyer each had a goal and two assists for UMD. On Saturday, Minnesota Duluth surrendered a 2-0 second period lead and suffered a 4-3 setback to the Buckeyes. Irwin, who had two assists in the series finale and a five-point weekend, now has 195 career points (74g, 121a), which ranks her as the sixth-highest scorer in program history. For Ohio State, the senior duo of Natalie Spooner and Laura McIntosh had a big weekend. Spooner totaled six points while McIntosh finished with three points en route to a new Ohio State record. Spooner had a pair of assists in the loss and then followed with her third hat trick of the season and one assist in the victory, scoring three of Ohio State's four goals. Spooner's six points moved her to 156 in her career, placing her third on the program's all-time leading points list. She also leads all current and former Buckeyes with 96 career goals. McIntosh, meanwhile, placed her name at the top of another OSU records list as she became the program's all-time career points leader. Entering the weekend in a tie for first with former Buckeye Jana Harrigan (2003-06) at 160, McIntosh's power-play goal at 10:42 broke the school record. She also tallied a pair of assists and has 163 career points. She leads all current and former Buckeyes with 119 career assists and has 44 career goals.

And at Ralph Engelstad Arena in Grand Forks, North Dakota became only the second team to sweep Bemidji State this season with 5-2 and 3-1 victories on Feb. 3-4. Right winger Jocelyne Lamoureux extended her nation-leading point total to 70 (28g, 42a) and tied her own school

record of 28 goals in a season. Left winger Michelle Karvinen led UND offensively against BSU with six points, including a natural hat trick and a four-point game last Friday. Defenseman Monique Lamoureux-Kolls had two goals, including the game-winner, on Saturday and had a four-point weekend while center Josefine Jakobsen had a goal in each game.

Looking ahead to the final weekend of the 2011-12 regular season – Friday and Saturday, Feb. 17-18 – there will again be four WCHA series contested as Minnesota hosts North Dakota, Ohio State visits Wisconsin, Minnesota Duluth hosts Minnesota State, and Bemidji State plays at St. Cloud State.

With the non-conference portion of the schedule complete, WCHA-member teams finished the regular season with a 33-7-6 record and .778 winning percentage against opponents from other Division 1 conferences. WCHA teams went 6-0-2 (.875) vs ECAC Hockey, 13-2-1 (.844) vs. the Hockey East Association, 8-5-3 (.594) vs. College Hockey America, and 6-0-0 vs. Independents.

Individually, North Dakota's Jocelyne Lamoureux (28-42=70), Wisconsin's Brianna Decker (29-35=64) and North Dakota's Monique Lamoureux-Kolls (24-39=63) rank first, second and third in the nation in scoring points, respectively. Decker is the top goal scorer with 29 while Lamoureux leads in assists with 42.

Minnesota's Megan Bozek leads the WCHA and is tied for first in the country in points by a defenseman with 32 while her Gophers' teammate Noora Rätty ranks first nationally in goals-against average with a mark of 1.41 and is fifth nationally and second in the WCHA in save percentage at .936. Wisconsin's Alex Rigsby leads the nation with a .949 save percentage, while her 805 saves is the second most in the nation. Rigsby also has the second-best goals-against average in the country at 1.46.

In the latest USCHO.com Div. 1 Women's College Hockey Poll released on Feb. 6, the WCHA had three of the top four ranked teams and four of the top nine. Defending WCHA and national champion Wisconsin continued at No. 1, Minnesota is at No. 2, North Dakota moved up to No. 4 and Minnesota Duluth is at No. 9. Also receiving votes was Bemidji State.

Home to a record 12 consecutive national championship teams, including the latest NCAA Frozen Four crown won by Wisconsin last spring, the women's Western Collegiate Hockey Association marks its 13th season in 2011-12.

The group has the most wins of any four-year class in Bemidji State women's hockey history.

With the six points, she becomes one of nine players in Gopher women's hockey history to score six points in a single game, a mark that ranks second in the Minnesota record book ... She was +1 in Friday's game and scored goals on two of the three shots she recorded ... Last Saturday, Kessel had two points with a goal and an assist in the Gophers' 7-0 victory ... Megan Bozek leads the nation in points by a defenseman with 32, with a career-best four assists last Friday ... Noora Rätty became Minnesota's record holder for career shutouts with her 22nd in Saturday's 7-0 win ... Rätty recorded 22 saves in last Friday's 8-1 win over St. Cloud State, allowing one goal ... In last Saturday's 7-0 win, Rätty tallied 14 saves, and had her sixth shutout this season ... She leads the nation in goals-against average at 1.41, and ranks fifth nationally and second in the WCHA in save percentage with a .936 ... Minnesota leads the nation in scoring defense, allowing just 1.37 goals per game ... The Gophers' penalty-kill ranks first in the WCHA and third nationally with a 88.5% success rate.

### Bulldogs

#### University of Minnesota Duluth

The No. 9 Bulldogs (15-12-1, 12-11-1-1 WCHA, 38 points) solved nothing in the WCHA race for first round, home-ice playoff advantage, splitting its series with Ohio State at AMSOIL Arena over the weekend ... The Bulldogs used four goals in the first 12 minutes last Friday night to knock off the Buckeyes 4-2 ... The furious start was the most goals UMD has scored in the first period since Jan. 30, 2009, when they scored five en route to a 7-2 win over St. Cloud State at the DECC ... Senior forward Haley Irwin and junior forward and linemate Audrey Cournoyer each had a goal and two assists for UMD last Friday ... The Bulldogs surrendered a 2-0 goal lead last Saturday and suffered a 4-3 setback to the Buckeyes ... Irwin had two assists but UMD served 19 minutes of penalties on the evening and just could not stay out of the box ... With the five-point weekend, Irwin has 195 career points as a Bulldog (74g, 121a), which ranks her as the sixth-highest scorer in program history ... Irwin also jumped into the No. 3 spot for career assists with 121, and her current run of 43 helpers is the fifth most in a season by any UMD player ... ### WCHA Women's Tie-Breaking Procedures - For Playoff Purposes Only

At the conclusion of the regular season, teams will be ranked by the number of points accumulated. If two teams are tied for first place, they will be declared co-WCHA champions.

The first round of the WCHA's post-season tournament will be a best-of-three games format at the home site of the teams ranked higher in the final regular season standings. All eight teams participate in the first round of the tournament. First round playoff pairings will be: #1 rank vs #8 rank, #2 rank vs #7 rank, #3 vs #6, and #4 vs #5.

Following the four first round series, the four winning teams will be re-seeded #1 thru #4 according to their standings in the final WCHA in-season competition and will advance to the WCHA FINAL FACE-OFF.

In the event that ties are encountered in the determination of WCHA ranking or designation of home teams for playoff purposes, the following procedures will be used in the order given to break the ties:

- If two or more teams are tied, head-to-head competition during the regular (conference) season will be used to break the tie.
- If two or more teams are still tied after (a), the highest seed will go to the team with the most WCHA (conference) wins during the regular season.
- If two or more teams played a four-game series during the regular season and the teams have the same win-loss records for those series and the same number of WCHA wins, the team having the least number of goals scored against it in the four-game series shall have the higher rank. If two or more teams played a two-game series during the regular season, proceed to tie-breaker d).
- If two or more teams are still tied after applying the provisions of (a), (b) and (c), the team having the greatest "winning margin" during the regular season will have the higher rank. Winning margin = WCHA goals for during the regular season minus WCHA goals against.
- Games played against WCHA opponents in holiday tournaments will not be counted in the determinations.
- Shootout wins used during the WCHA regular season will not be counted in the determinations. Shootout games will be recorded as a tie in the determinations.
