**10 Players With WCHA Ties Named to  
U.S. Four Nations Cup Roster**

*Four current and six former WCHA athletes will represent USA Hockey from Nov. 4-8*

EDINA, Minn. – Continuing to make a mark on international ice, 10 current or former players from the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) have been named to the U.S. Women's National Team that will compete in the Four Nations Cup, Nov. 4-8 in Kamloops, British Columbia. USA Hockey made its roster and schedule announcement for the upcoming tournament earlier today.

The quartet of current WCHA student-athletes selected to don the Team USA sweater are: **Hannah Brandt** (Jr., F, Minnesota), **Dani Cameranesi** (So., F, Minnesota), **Annie Pankowski** (Fr., F, Wisconsin) and **Lee Stecklein** (So., D Minnesota).

Former WCHA standouts **Megan Bozek** (D, Minnesota), **Brianna Decker** (F, Wisconsin), **Hilary Knight** (F, Wisconsin), **Monique Lamoureux** (D, North Dakota), **Gigi Marvin** (D, Minnesota) and **Alex Rigsby** (G, Wisconsin) were also named to the 23-player roster.

"The student-athletes and alumni of the WCHA have long made a significant impact on the sport of women's hockey, both throughout the NCAA and on the international stage," said Commissioner **Aaron Kemp**. "We are thrilled to see this tradition continue at the Four Nations Cup. It's a tremendous accomplishment for these exceptional players, who are certainly deserving of this honor. We look forward to watching them compete for USA Hockey."

The U.S. will open the Four Nations Cup against Finland at 3 p.m. CT on Tuesday, Nov. 4. Pool play continues against Canada on Wednesday, Nov. 5 (9 p.m. CT) before concluding with a Friday, Nov. 7 matchup with Sweden (3 p.m. CT). The third place and championship games will be held Saturday, Nov. 8 at 3 p.m. and 9 p.m. CT, respectively.
